

Treff.punkt – House rules

- We do not tolerate any form of discrimination, such as racism, nationalism, sexism, anti-semitism, ableism, queerphobia, etc. as well as
→ encouraging/calling for violent resistance, crimes and militarism.

We understand that in our society, discriminatory behavior is produced and reproduced due to socialisation and internalization of several forms of discrimination. All people make mistakes sometimes. The treff.punkt should serve as a space to question these structures, reflect upon them and learn from each other. Our goal is to learn to live together without excluding minorities, leaving each other alone or discriminating against each other.

We have a “key person“, who has the key with them for each day, and several “room openers“, whose responsibility it is to care of the room in certain hours of the day. These people are allowed to expel individuals or groups from the premises in an emergency. However, this should never be the first

solution for we will always try to look for a dialogic, non-violent form of conflict negotiation first.

1. Cooking or open fire

a. Cooking as well as open fires are not permitted on the treff.punkt premises.

2. Volume

a. Since there are rental apartments all around, a maximum volume of 80 decibels (dB) is permitted in the treff.punkt premises during opening hours (regularly 12 p.m. to 8 p.m.).

b. Sound transmission devices are not permitted.

c. Loud music is prohibited between 1:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. and after 8:00 p.m

3. The treff.punkt is a drug-free space

a. No alcohol, no cigarettes, no cannabis, no other drugs.

b. Please refrain from smoking/using weed right in front of the door. Just move a few meters to the side.

c. Coffee and tea products are excluded from this rule.

4. You can always bring food with you. We rely on food donations.

5. Garbage

a. Please take any rubbish you bring with you or dispose it in our rubbish bins.

6. Please leave the premises as clean as you found them/as clean as you would like to find them again

a. Cleaning utensils etc. can be found on the 1st floor in the storage room

7. Toilet use is

a. free for everyone. The toilets are in the basement and are therefore unfortunately not barrier-free.

i. Barrier-free toilets nearby:

Walltorstr.3, Sonnenstr.12, McDonalds (lebenshilfe?)

b. Please leave the toilets clean and let us know if there is a lack of toilet paper or soap. Feel free to clean the toilets if you feel like it, then you'll

take a little work off of the opening of the room and make the meeting point a little nicer.

8. Treating each other respectfully

a. We treat other people with respect and we listen to them. We treat others the way we would like to be treated ourselves.
